2008 Rules Interpretation



Rule Number: 15-5.1 Date: August 5, 2008

Page in rulebook: 59

Written description of rule and interpretation:

15-5.1 A minimum of 30 minutes driving time is required to be eligible for driver points. A driver must drive at least one lap on-track under green flag conditions and red flag time will not be counted. Here is the interpretation, offered in response to many recurring questions: 1. The requirement for 30 minutes of driving time for a driver to earn driver championship points will be measured at the scoring line on the race track as read by the driver I.D transponder. Interpretation of the 45 minute rule: In races where a pit stop is mandated prior to a specific time in the race, the point where the car must be past in order to fulfill the requirement will be the point designating the beginning of the entrance into the pit lane (or as specifically designated in the pre-race drivers briefing.)
