### **GENERAL AUTOMOBILE REGS**

**(Add)**

**4-2.2 Batteries** (Effective date March 15, 2010) - All batteries must be lead-acid technology, either wet cell, AGM, or gel-cell matrix permitted. No other forms of electrochemical energy storage are allowed. 12-volt systems only - must be securely mounted, sealed and insulated.

#### **15-5 In-Car Camera**

All ROLEX Sports Car Series Daytona Prototype and GT cars must mount on their roof either an actual in-car camera or the in-car camera replacement dummy unit. The unmodified dummy unit must be mounted on the opposite side of center-line of the car from the driver 12.5 inches rearward of the trailing edge of the windshield and 4.5 inches off of the centerline of the roof. Each dummy unit is dimensionally identical to an actual camera unit. The dummy unit is available in advance from BSR as part # BSR.CP.2004 (contact BSR, 704-795-0901) or is available at the track from the BSR/Hutch trailer.
